General :- Strapping Machines should be of reputed and proven make and essentially should have been used more than three years in Sri Lanka, preferably of either a Japanese or European origin. Machine should be designed for continuous and trouble free operation with absolutely minimum failure rate. Further, Machine should be tropicalized to be suitable for Sri Lanka.

Strap Width : 9,12,15,19 mm (Change kits & adjustments)
Sealing Method : Heat Sealing

Packing Size : Width - 100 - 850 mm

Warranty : One year onsite comprehensive warranty
