Studying in Britain: Information

- Students from Sri Lanka can study in the UK if they have the right qualifications. This usually means an appropriate number of Sri Lankan or London "O" and "A" levels and an appropriate level of English language skills.
- Several different qualifications are offered by British educational institutions. The main ones are:

Qualification	Entrance requirement
Postgraduate degrees: PhD, MA, MSc, MBA	An appropriate first degree / other professional qualification and work experience
Undergraduate degrees: BA, BSc, MBBS, LLB	Appropriate "O" Levels + "A" Levels + an appropriate level of English, or other professional qualification (i.e. IB, HND)
Foundation degrees:	"A" levels + an appropriate level of English
Career based courses: National Diplomas (ND) National Vocational Qualification (NVQ)	Appropriate "O" Levels + an appropriate level of English
