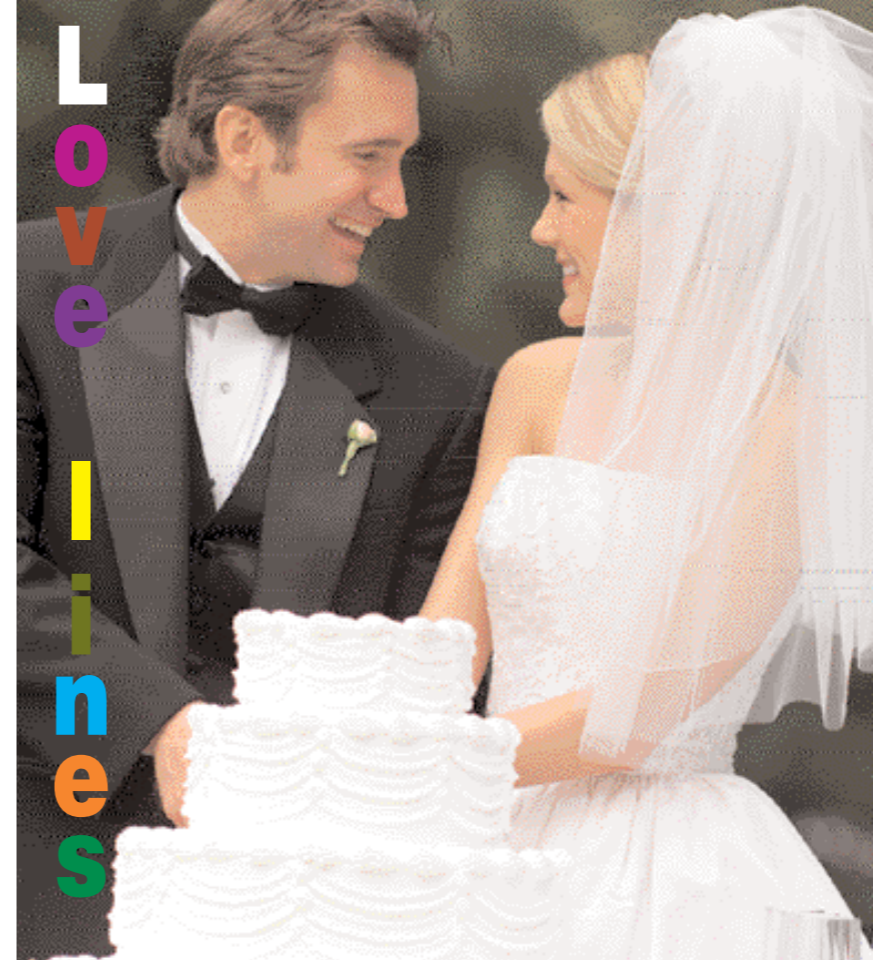
**Existence of love**
