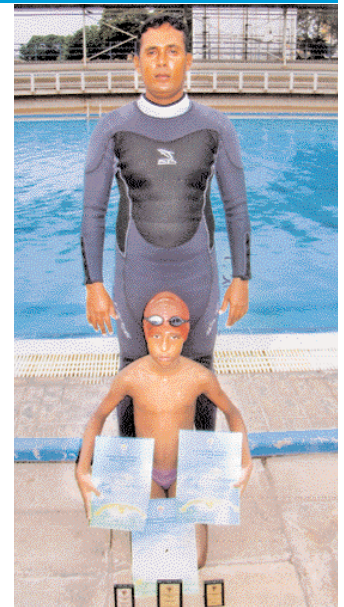
Award winners
