

Follow Sri Lanka team at ICC World Cup 2011

History: Sri Lanka has taken part in all previous World Cup tournaments since 1975. Though Sri Lanka gained full membership of the ICC only in 1981, Sri Lanka had the honour of participating at the two World Cup tournaments prior to that in 1975 and 1979 as an Associate Member of the ICC.

Tournament data: During the past eight World Cup tournaments, Sri Lanka has played a total of 57 matches, winning 25 of them, losing 30 games with one tie and a no result.

Official warm-up matches: Beat Netherlands in the first warm-up match played yesterday and are down to play the West Indies in the remaining warm-up match to be played at the Premadasa Stadium on Tuesday (15).
