

Lankan wins UK County Council polls

Conservative Party stalwart Sujan Wickremaratchi was recently elected Member for Haywards Heath Town division in the West Sussex County Council election. Wickremaratchi gained the Haywards Heath Town from Labour. He received 951 votes, UKIP candidate Howard Burrell received 614.

He is the first Sri Lankan to win at this County and his victory came after 25 years of Liberal Democrat rule.
