Adverb

What is Adverb?

It is a word that describes about a verb or verb phrase.

It gives an answer for questions such as How? When? Where? Why? in a sentence.

Dear kids, let us learn what is an adverb with a few examples here.



Here are some Examples:

- 1) She sings loudly.

Adverb

In the above example, '**loudly**' is an Adverb, which modifies the verb sing.

- 2) She paints well.

Adverb

In the above example, '**well**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'how she paints'

- 3) They went home quickly.

Adverb

In the above example, '**quickly**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'how they went home?'

WHAT?

- 4) Pappu went to park yesterday.

Adverb

In the above example, '**yesterday**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'when does Pappu goes to park?'

- 5) She works hard.

Adverb

In the above example, '**hard**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'how she works?'

- 6) It rains all day.

Adverb

In the above example, '**all day**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'how it rains'.

- 7) Have you understood completely?

Adverb

In the above example, '**completely**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'how does she understands.'

- 8) She plays the piano beautifully.

Adverb

In the above example, '**beautifully**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'how she played the piano.'

- 9) She often speaks like this.

Adverb

In the above example, '**often**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'When does she speak like this'.

- 10) That was a graceful dance.

Adverb

In the above example, '**graceful**' is an Adverb, which answers the question 'how the dance performance was.'
