The World Cup Cricket Tournament is being co-hosted by India, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh from February 19-April 2. In Sri Lanka the matches will be played at three venues : Colombo, Kandy and Hambantota

● Mahinda Rajapaksa International Cricket Stadium, Sooriyawewa, Hambantota



Mahinda Rajapaksa International Cricket Stadium is the newly built stadium specially for ICC World Cup 2011 in Hambantota. It has a capacity for 35,000 people and is floodlit. The Stadium will host two league matches of 2011 ICC Cricket World Cup.

Ranasinghe Premadasa Stadium is one of the main cricket venues in Sri Lanka situated on Khetarama Road, Maligawatta, Colombo and formerly known as Khetarama Cricket Stadium. Premadasa Stadium has a capacity for 35,000 people and will host 7 matches of 2011 ICC World Cup including 1 Quarter-Final and one Semi-Final match.

Pallekele International Cricket Stadium is a new stadium for 2011 ICC Cricket World Cup in the city of Kandy, Sri Lanka. The Stadium established in 2009. Pallekele Cricket Stadium will host 3 league matches of 2011 ICC World Cup. The Stadium has the capacity – 35,000 people and is floodlit.
