Work commences on housing project in North and East

With the shift from relief and rehabilitation phase to the reconstruction and development phase, the Government of India has agreed to fund the construction of 50,000 houses in Northern and Eastern Sri Lanka.

While the bulk of the project will focus on the needs in the Northern Province, it will also cover some areas of the Eastern and Central Provinces. Work has already begun on a pilot project of one thousand houses, which will spread over all five districts of the Northern Province.
